Lena Water System was established in 1976 to serve the rural communities in the surrounding area. Including Lena, Sharp, Taylor Hill, Marco, Gorum, Flatwoods, Mora, Clifton, Derry, Chopin, and parts of Cloutierville. The system now serves approximately 1150 service connections. All of the water system is made of PVC main distribution lines and have all P.E. service lines. There is no lead and copper main or service lines included in the system. The Lena Water System utilizes a Zinc Orthophosphate in the treatment process which helps with corrosion control. This provides corrosion control in the houses that use lead and copper plumbing. The Lena Water System is on a 3 year cycle for sampling of lead and copper in houses that were determined to have lead and copper plumbing to check for corrosion. In the past years of sampling, the Lena Water System have had no known issues and have been in compliance with-in the state and federal regulations from the Department of Health and Hospitals(DHH) for the amount of lead and copper that can be in the water.
